

The Board of Directors of the East Tennessee School Band and Orchestra Association (ETSBOA) is seeking interested college students to serve as the **College Student Representative** to the Board. The duties of the position are as outlined from our association by-laws below:

“Section 14: The **College Student Representative**, a non-voting position appointed by the board, is a current college student, whose duties would be to work with the College Representative to raise awareness of our student membership within ETSBOA, and in conjunction with the various education professors at various colleges and to encourage membership of music education students. The purpose is to reach future band directors with the intention of networking with our membership. He would attend and even participate in the audition process and help with the administration of clinics with the Area Representatives. The duties of the College Student Representative would be to (1) coordinate student members wanting to either shadow or participate in various activities, and (2) coordinate caucus meetings at the Fall and Winter General Meetings.”

The current expected responsibilities also includes maintaining and updating a database of current music majors at every college and university in the ETSBOA region with an interest in making themselves available for private lessons and/or group instruction of area middle and high school bands and orchestras.

The successful applicant will be an enthusiastic and outgoing individual with great organizational skills and a lots of self-directed initiative.

Review of applications will begin Friday, February 8, 2019 and continue until a suitable candidate is selected.
