Snare Drum Instructions:

Each student must furnish his/her own snare drum sticks

Rudiments:

Single Paradiddle, Flam Tap, Flam Accent

Students will play 2 of these (chosen at auditions)

Rudiments must be played open (slow) to closed (fast) and back to open.

Buzz Roll/Multiple Bounce Roll:

Must be performed soft to loud to soft.
