

Zack Williamson has taught band for 36 years in Tennessee, the last 33 years at Roane County High School in Kingston. His Wind Ensemble, Concert and Marching Bands consistently received superior ratings and the Roane County Band was selected to perform at the TMEA Conference in 2000, 2009 and 2019.

Williamson received his Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville and his Master of Education degree from Lincoln Memorial University. He

was awarded his Specialist in Education degree from Tennessee Technological University. Williamson has served on the Board of Directors for the East Tennessee Schools Band and Orchestra Association as Lower Area Representative and as Jazz Chairman. He is past-president of the Tennessee Bandmasters Association and past-president for the Tennessee Secondary School Band Directors Association. Williamson also holds membership in the American School Band Directors Association and is a member of Phi Beta Mu. Williamson was elected to the John Philip Sousa Foundation Legion of Honor in 2020.

For over thirty years, Williamson served his country as an active member of the 572nd Air Force Band (Tennessee Air National Guard) and has served numerous times as an adjudicator and clinician at various events.
